Hence, it is,

O R D E R E D

that the accused persons, namely, Ayush Yadav and Anurag Tiwary are found not guilty of the offence punishable u/s 21(C)/29 of NDPS Act and they are acquitted u/s 235 (1) Cr. P.C. from the charge labelled against them.

The bail bonds shall remain in force for next 6 months as per the ratio of section 437A of Cr. P.C.

It is to be mentioned here that in view of the direction of the Hon'ble Court in Ayush Yadav and Anurag Tiwary vs State of West Bengal, the State has a right to appeal against this judgment of acquittal. Since, the complainant is State, no question arises regarding liberty to the complainant to appeal through D.L.S.A., Jhargram availing free legal aid.
