Record is put up today on the strength of a put up petition along with a petition filed on behalf of custody accused Sajal Sk praying for bail on the ground as stated therein.

Copy served.

Ld. PP in charge and the Ld. Lawyers of the accused are present.

Now the bail petition filed on behalf of above accused person is taken up for hearing.

Heard both sides.

It is submitted by the Ld. Advocates for the above accused person that he has been falsely implicated in this case and has permanent residences in the locality. So, he may be granted bail in any terms and conditions.

Ld. PP in charge oppose the bail prayer considering the nature of the offence where huge quantity of narcotic substances were seized and charge-sheet has been submitted in connection with this case within the statutory period.

Perused the materials on record and submission.

Having heard the submission of both sides and on perusal of the case record I find that huge quantity of narcotic substance (255.32 gram Heroin) have allegedly been recovered from the possession of the accused person which is commercial quantity in nature for which no such benefit could be extended to him in view of section 37 of NDPS Act in this regard. Moreover charge-sheet u/s 21(C)/29 of The NDPS Act has been submitted in this case and there are sufficient incriminating materials against the accused person for the offence and the case is at the stage of consideration of charge.

Considering recovery of commercial quantity of Narcotic substance and gravity of offence, I am not inclined to enlarge accused person on bail at this stage. Hence prayer for bail in respect of accused Sajal Sk stands **rejected**.
