

Order No. 126 dt. 22.7.24

Today is fixed for appearance and evidence.

All the ten accused persons on court bail are present and have filed their hazira before this court.

The witnesses slated to depose today are found absent before this court. No communication has been received from the Director of Health Services West Bengal Government although summons was sent to him by postal service on the last occasion for causing the summons to be served upon the three Government doctors namely Dr Binoy Majumder, Dr Amal Biswas and Dr Dilip Bhattacharya. Report has been received from CMOH Alipurduar to the effect that Dr Dilip Bhattacharya and Dr Amal Biswas were transferred from Falakata RH Alipurduar approximately 25 years ago. Let the reports be kept with the record.

Let fresh summons be sent to Director of Health Services with respect to the above doctors who is directed to cause service of the said summons on or by the next date and give report to this court thereof on or by the next date positively without fail i.d. this court would be constrained to pass necessary order against the said Officer as the present case needs to be disposed of at the earliest in compliance with the directions of the Hon'ble Calcutta High Court given in CRR 730 of 2009.

Let a copy of this order along with fresh summons be sent to Director of Health Services, West Bengal Government for compliance.
