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First Bail application Under Section 438 Cr.PC.

ORDER:

Today SI Avtar Singh No.3206/Amritsar of Homicide Forensic Unit, Amritsar has appeared and suffered a statement that applicants/accused Sawinderpal Bhagat, Narinder Soni and Deepak Kumar have joined the investigation with police on 30.01.2021 vide zimini No.18 in compliance of the interim directions of the court but accused Sawinderpal Bhagat neither got recovered the danda used during the occurrence nor disclosed the whereabouts of the other accused persons who were accompanying them during the occurrence. He further stated that custodial interrogation of above said accused is required to recover the danda used during the occurrence as well as to know the whereabouts of other accused persons.

Heard. The relief of anticipatory bail cannot be declined to the applicants merely on the ground that recovery of a danda is to be effected from applicant Sawinderpal Bhagat or that they have not disclosed the whereabouts of the other accused persons who were accompanying them during the occurrence. Since the applicants Sawinderpal Bhagat, Narinder Soni and Deepak Kumar in compliance of the orders of this court have already joined the investigation, their custodial interrogation does not seem necessary.

Resultantly, this bail application filed by the applicants Sawinderpal Bhagat, Narinder Soni and Deepak Kumar under section 438 Cr.PC stands allowed and interim bail order dated 18.01.2021 passed by

this court is made absolute subject to conditions under section 438(2) Cr.PC. These applicants are further directed to join investigation as and when so required. Bail application file be consigned to record room.
