ORDER:

ASI Boota Singh No.608/FZK appeared and suffered statement to the effect that recovery has been effected in the present case and there is no other bail application of accused pending in any other court.

2. This order of mine shall dispose of bail application moved by the counsel for the accused/applicant **Sukhdev Singh son of Dalip Singh, resident of village Chandmari @ Saido Ke Uttar, Police Station Sadar Jalalabad, Tehsil Jalalabad & District Fazilka**, wherein it has been averred that there is not an iota of truth. Accused-applicant has never committed such offence. The accused-applicant has no concern with the alleged occurrence. He has been falsely implicated in the present FIR. The applicant/accused is an innocent person. Nothing has been recovered from the applicant/accused. He is in **custody since 26.12.2025**. Hence, this application.

3. Learned APP for the State did not file the reply but argued that accused-applicant shall not be released on bail keeping in view the

nature of the offence.

4. I have heard learned defence counsel and learned APP for the State on the application for bail of accused. The present FIR has been registered against the accused-applicant on the basis of secret information received **on 25.12.2025** before ASI Buta Singh that accused-applicant Sukhdev Singh son of Dalip Singh and co-accused Surjeet Singh son of Jangir Singh, are habitual of committing theft of Buses and further sell the same to the customers after preparing their forged engine & chasis numbers. If raid be conducted at the disclosed place, they can be apprehended red handed. On the basis of secret information, present FIR registered against the accused. Raid was conducted at the disclosed place where a person was seen along with a bus bearing Chasis No.MB1PBEHC5AALB9933 Engine No.LAH653235 of MARGENTA COLOUR Model, 2010, who upon seeing the police party tried to flee away but with the assistance of police official he was apprehended. On inquired he disclosed his name Sukhdev Singh accused-applicant. He is taken into police custody. Recovered bus was also taken into police possession vide recovery memo which was witnessed by the witnesses. During police remand, one more bus bearing RC No. RJ 49 PA 0174 has been got recovered. Accused-applicant was **arrested in this case on 26.12.2025** and since he is in custody.

5. Accused-applicant is in custody **since 26.12.2025**. Recovery has already been effected in the present FIR. The remaining investigation pertain to documentary evidence. No statement of the owner of the

said recovered buses has been recorded as yet. The offence under Section 318 (4), 336 (2), 338, 336 (3), 340 (2) BNS is debatable. Nothing remains to be recovered from the accused-applicant. Even presentation of challan may take some time.

6. Hence, the application in hand stands **allowed**. The accused-applicant **Sukhdev Singh** is admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds in the sum of **Rs.60,000/- with one surety** in like amount, subject to the conditions as under:-

- Applicant shall appear before the learned trial court on each and every date of hearing.
- Applicant shall not leave India without prior permission of learned trial court.
- Applicant shall not make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with this case.

The bail bonds and surety bonds not furnished. Papers be attached with the remand papers.

Further, in view of directions dated 31.01.2023 by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India pertaining to bail matters, duly conveyed to all the Courts and further in view of office order dated 19.04.2023 bearing Endst.No.2826/EB and 2827/EB – both dated 19.04.2023 from office of Learned District & Sessions Judge, Fazilka, copy of this order be supplied/provided to System Assistant for forwarding the same to concerned Jail Authorities, in its letter and spirit. Apart from that the P.L.V. (Para-Legal Volunteer) attached with Front Office be supplied

additional copy of this order to assist the System Assistant in said matter.
