

NDPS Case No. 12 of 2025

Order No. 16

Today is fixed for production and I.O.'s report.

Accused Biplab Chaki is produced from J.C. through V.C. and remanded to further J.C till next date.

A bail petition is filed for the accused Biplab Chaki praying for bail on the ground stated therein.

Ld. Special PP for NCB and Ld. Lawyer for the accused are present.

Now the bail petition is taken up for hearing.

Heard both sides.

It is submitted by the Ld advocate for the accused Biplab Chaki that accused is innocent, sole earning member of his family and has been falsely implicated in this case. Therefore, the accused person may be granted bail at any terms and conditions.

Having heard the submission of both sides and materials on record, I find that huge quantity of contraband articles have been seized from the accused person which is commercial quantity in nature for which no such benefit could have been extended to him in view of section 37 of NDPS Act in this regard. This is a case u/s 8(c)/20(b)(ii)(C)/25 of NDPS Act and there are sufficient incriminating materials for the offence against the above accused and therefore bail prayer of the accused person may not be allowed.

Under the above circumstances and considering the nature of offence , I am not inclined to enlarge the accused person on bail. Hence prayer for bail in respect of above accused Biplab Chaki stands rejected.
