Accused/applicant has moved the present bail application
under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail.

Learned counsel for accused has argued that the present has
been case of version case and cross version. In fact the son of the
accused/applicant was mercilessly beaten up and even the allegations
upon the accused /applicant has been just causing of simple injuries.

Learned APP for the State has opposed the bail application
on the ground of seriousness of the offence.

Record has been received and perused. As per the contents
of the FIR on 04.04.2019 at about 8:00 pm complainant Resham Singh
alongwith his brother Arashdeep Singh had been going to the house of
Sukhchain Singh Sarpanch and after leaving the trolley over there and

they having coming back and on the way Ranjit Singh alongwith his son Subhpreet Singh and his wife Jaswinder Kaur came in front of tractor and Ranjit Singh raised lalkara to teach a lesson for playing deck on high volume. Subhpreet Singh took out a sword from his house and gave sword blow hitting him on his left arm. Ranjit Singh gave Iron Rod blow, Jaswinder Kaur gave baseball blow. Vide Rapat No. 29 dated 05.04.2019 cross version on the statement of Subhpreet Singh has already been registered whereby it was on 04.04.2019 at about 8:00 pm when they had objected to Resham Singh, Arashdeep Singh and Manjit Singh from playing deck on their tractor in high volume then they came on respective cars alongwith Sukchain Singh, Talwinder Singh, Gurwinder Singh, Gurchet Singh, Sher Singh, Lakhbir Singh and Gursewak Singh even on motorcycle as well alongwith 5/6 unknown persons. Sukhchain Singh armed with 32 bore riffle, Resham Singh armed with baseball bat, Arshdeep Singh armed with Dang, Manjit Singh armed with Kirpan Singh, Gurchet Singh armed with dang, Talwinder Singh armed with Dattar, Guriwnder singh armed with Dang, Sher Singh armed with Gandasi, Gursewak Singh armed with baseball bat, Gursahib armed with Dang came over there. Resham Singh gave baseball bat blow on Subhpreet Singh hitting him on his head. Manjit Singh gave Kirpan blow hitting him on his head. Gurwinder Singh gave also caused injuries on his back while he was running towards his house even Gurchet Singh gave dang blow on his back. Even his mother and grand mother fell upon him to save him. The

copy of one report of Medical Board also placed on record whereby it was contended that injuries on the person of Resham Singh with injury no. 4 which was declared as grievous it has been caused by friendly hand. In the entire facts and circumstances and the abovesaid discussion, given there being a case of version and cross version, son of the applicant/accused aging about 18 years old having being caused many injuries, grievous injuries even not attributed upon the accused/applicant, it having been attributed to co-accused and above all grievous injuries also opined to be result of friendly hand, in such facts and circumstances, this court is of view that it would be in the fitness of things and in the better interests of investigation that the applicant-accused is directed to join the investigation till 20.08.2019 and in such event the applicant/accused shall be admitted on interim bail to the satisfaction of arresting officer/investigation officer/SHO concerned of the police station subject to conditions:-

- a) The applicant shall join the investigation and cooperate with the same as and when called by the investigation officer.
- b) She will not tamper with the prosecution evidence.
- c) She will not leave the country without prior permission of the court.

Report be submitted in this court and for consideration on the said date.
