ORDER:

1. The present bail application being urgent in nature has been presented before the Court of the undersigned being Duty Judge.
2. The instant bail application for grant of blanket anticipatory bail under section 438(i) of Cr.P.C., has been filed by the applicants, named above.
3. It is further averred in the application by the applicant that one Lovepreet Singh alias Labha s/o Manohar Singh is her neighbour and

on 24.04.2020 some bad words were passed by him and his wife Saroj Rani against her and her husband Jasbeer Singh. Now aforesaid Lovepreet Singh alias Labha and his wife Saroj are moving false applications against applicant and her husband in PS Lakho Ke Behram. Now during the delivery of child, said Saroj Rani died due to the negligence of doctor, but said Lovepreet Singh alias Labha in connivance with police of PS Lakho Ke Behram is regularly harassing applicant and her other family members and raiding the house of applicant on the ground that Saroj Rani had died only because of applicant and her other family members and applicant apprehends her arrest, harassment and detention at the hands of police at any moment. Hence, the present bail application.

4. Notice of the bail application was given to the State. Sh.Balwinder Singh, Additional PP has appeared on behalf of the State-respondent. Report from the concerned police station was called.

5. This Court has heard learned counsel for the applicant and Learned Additional PP for the State and have also perused the case file carefully and minutely.

6. As per the report received from the SHO of PS Lakho Ke Behram, dated 28.08.2020, that on 22.05.2020 at about 10/11 am, applicant Reeta Rani, Habans Kaur and Chhindo Rani had quarrel with Manpreet Kaur wife of Lovepreet Singh (who has expired later on) and accordingly a rapat under Sections 323/34 of IPC has been registered and a Kalandhra under Section 107/151 of Cr.P.C. has been presented in the Court of SDM, Guru Har Sahai. The viscera of Manpreet Kaur has been sent to Guru Gobind Singh Medical College and Hospital, Faridkot and above said Manpreet Kaur expired after the lapse of one month and 20 days of the above said occurrence.

7. As per the report of SHO of PS Lakho Ke Behram, only a rapat under Sections 323/34 of IPC has been made in the police station and a Kalandhra under Sections 107/151 of Cr.P.C. has been presented in the Court of SDM, Guru Har Sahai, which is for bailable offences.

8. So, in view of the aforementioned facts and circumstances of the case and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present bail application has become infructuous and stands dismissed. File be consigned to Record Room.
