ORDER

1) Bail applications received by entustment. It be checked and registered and be also shown in CIS system. Notice of the same has been issued to the learned Addl.PP for State, present in the court. Vide this common order, I shall dispose of the aforesaid two applications for grant of bail filed by the above referred applicants-accused under Section 482 of the

B.N.S.S. as same are arising out of case bearing FIR No.149 dated 31.07.2024, Under Sections 409, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC (old), new U/ss 316(5), 318 (4), 336 (2), 338, 336(3), 340 (2), 61 (2) of B.N.S.S, 2023, registered at police station City Moga.

2) Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the accused/applicant Jaswinder Singh submitted that applicant is quite innocent and has been falsely implicated in the present case as she has not committed any offence as alleged in the FIR. He has also submitted that the accused/applicant had applied for the post of Education Service Provider and Teaching Fellows and applicant has been selected for the post of teaching fellows and applicant joined in Elementary Government School at village Wander on 27.09.2008. The applicant has performed his duties upto 24.10.2009. He further submitted that so far as experience certificate for the period 15.02.2000 to March 2001 of B.S.H.Shivalik Public School, Paras Ram Nagar, Bathinda issued by Principal of said school under her signature and seal, duly counter signed by District Education Officer, Bathinda is legal and valid one. He further submitted that the controversy with regard to said experience certificate was also arose and a thorough and detailed inquiry was conducted and same certificate was found to be genuine one. The whole investigation is based upon documentary evidence. The accused/applicant is ready to join the investigation. Since, nothing is to be recovered from the accused/applicant, as such his custodial interrogation is not required. With these submissions, he requested for according interim bail to the applicant till the final decision of this bail application.

3) Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the accused/applicant Gurwinder Singh submitted that applicant is quite innocent and has been falsely implicated in the present case as she has not committed any offence as alleged in the FIR. He has also submitted that the accused/applicant had applied for the post of Education Service Provider and Teaching Fellows and applicant has been selected for the post of teaching fellows and applicant joined at village Khosa Kotla, Elementary Government School Moga, Block-2 on 14.11.2008. The applicant has performed his duties upto 24.10.2009. He further submitted that so far as experience certificate for the

period 09.09.2004 to 10.09.2007 of Shri Guru Harkrishan Modern School, Wadala Granthian, Gurdaspur issued by Principal of said school under her signature and seal, duly counter signed by District Education Officer, Gurdaspur is legal and valid one. He further submitted that the controversy with regard to said experience certificate was also arose and a thorough and detailed inquiry was conducted and same certificate was found to be genuine one. The whole investigation is based upon documentary evidence. The accused/applicant is ready to join the investigation. Since, nothing is to be recovered from the accused/applicant, as such his custodial interrogation is not required. With these submissions, he requested for according interim bail to the applicant till the final decision of this bail application.

4. Heard. At this juncture, without going into the merits of the instant case, the aforesaid applicants-accused are hereby, directed to cause appearance before the IO/SHO of PS City Moga and in case of their doing so, they shall be admitted to interim bail till 21.08.2024 on furnishing bail bonds in the sum of ₹ 50,000/- with one surety each in the like amount to the satisfaction of IO/SHO of PS City Moga with the direction that the applicants shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade them from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer and the applicants shall not leave the country without the prior permission of the Court.
