(Arising out of Sahebganj PS Case No. 228/25 dated 26.04.2025)

Today is fixed for production/ SR of absconding accused and hearing of discharge of accused Safikul Islam as prayed for by the I.O.

Accused Rahul Islam and Anichur Islam @ Anichur Rahaman @ Bapi are produced from J.C. and remanded to further J.C. till next date.

No bail petition is filed on behalf of accused Rahul Islam and Anichur Islam @ Anichur Rahaman @ Bapi as stated by their learned Advocate.

Ld. PP in charge and the Ld. Lawyer of the accused are present.

The defacto complainant SI Rahu Oraon presently posted at Haldibari PS is present by filing a petition through prosecution praying for no objection against the prayer of I.O. for discharge of accused Safikul Islam on the ground stated therein.

Ld. PP in charge submits that when the defacto complainant raised no objection, the accused Safikul Islam may be discharged from this case.

During hearing defacto complainant submits that he has no objection if the accused Safikul Islam is discharged from this case and in support of his contention he has submitted a prayer.

Considering all aspects and submissions as well as CD, I find that the prayer of I.O. for discharging the accused person namely Safikul Islam should be considered and allowed when I.O. has prayed for discharge of accused Safikul Islam and defacto complainant himself has no objection in this regard. Accordingly, prayer of I.O. is allowed and let the accused Safikul Islam be discharged from this case and to note in the charge-sheet.

On perusal of the case record it appears that in compliance of earlier orderailable WA upon accused Asraful Haque has not been issued.

BC-II is directed to comply.
