ORDER:

Present order of mine shall dispose off bail application filed by
applicant-Nandni Devi.

2. Brief facts of the bail application are that applicant has been
falsely implicated in the present case on the basis of false and flimsy
grounds. It has been stated that applicant was not joined during inquiry
before nominating in the present case. It has been further stated that police
has registered the present case under political pressure. It has been further
stated that applicant never visited Abohar nor she knew or met the
complainant. It has been further stated that applicant was arrested on

17.08.2021 and till then she is in judicial lock up. It has been stated that offences are triable by Judicial Magistrate Ist Class and the guilt of applicant is yet to be established. It has been further stated that nothing more is to be recovered from the applicant. Hence, it is prayed that applicant be admitted to bail.

3. Upon notice, learned Addl.PP for State appeared and contested the bail application. He has argued that similar bail application of co-accused Anoop Patel has already been dismissed by learned predecessor of this court on 09.03.2021. He has further argued that anticipatory bail application of co-accused Rajinder Kumar has also been dismissed on 09.01.2020. Hence, prayed that present bail application be dismissed.

4. I have heard learned counsel for applicant, learned Addl.PP for State and have gone through the records of the case file carefully.

5. The present FIR has been registered against the applicant and others on the application moved by complainant Sandeep Kumar before SSP, Fazilka, whereby it was informed that applicant-accused and others formed a gang and they in connivance with each other took Rs.12,00,000/- from complainant on the pretext of providing them employment in Railway Department. It was further alleged that accused-applicant and others also used to forge the official papers of Railway Department. It was further alleged that accused-applicant neither returned Rs.12,00,000/- nor they provided any employment to complainant and committed cheating of Rs.12,00,000/- with the complainant. After going through the allegations levelled in the FIR as well as the police record, it transpires that applicant had been receiving the amount from the complainant on the pretext of providing him employment in railway department. There are further allegations against the applicant that she has connived with co-accused to

take hefty amount of Rs.12,00,000/- from the complainant on the pretext of providing him employment in the railway department. There are further allegations that applicant is member of gang alongwith her co-accused and they have also forged the papers of railway department. Considering the aforesaid allegations, I am of the view that they are serious in nature. I find no merits in the present bail application and same is hereby dismissed. File be consigned to the record room.
