ORDER

Heard on bail application under Section 483 of BNSS filed
by above named applicant/accused in the above noted case FIR.

2. Notice of the bail application was served upon the State and
record of the police station was requisitioned.

3. As per the prosecution version, on 05.05.2025, in the area of
police station Dharamkot, on the basis of secret information, 7 gram of
Heroin was recovered from the transparent polythene bag (lifafa) thrown
by present applicant/accused Gurmeet Singh alias Babbu. Statement of
Investigating Officer/ASI Gurbinder Singh has been recorded separately,
in this regard.

4. Apparently, the alleged recovery of 7 gram heroin, effected
from the accused/applicant falls within the ambit of non commercial

category. The applicant/accused has been arrested in this case on 05.05.2025 and since then he is in custody. The presentation of challan and thereafter, conclusion of trial shall take considerable time. Criminal liability of the applicant/accused, if any, shall be determined on culmination of the trial. No useful purpose would be served by keeping the applicant/accused behind the bars for an indefinite period. Co-accused has been granted bail by this Court. Without much commenting upon merits of the case, the bail application is allowed and the applicant/accused Gurmeet Singh alias Babbu is ordered to be released on bail subject to furnishing bail bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount, subject to the following terms:-

1. that accused/applicant will not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the court or to any police officer;
2. that accused/applicant shall not leave the country without prior permission of the court;
3. that the accused/applicant shall appear in the court on each and every date of hearing;
4. that in future if, accused/applicant is found indulged in similar kind of activities, prosecution would be at liberty to seek cancellation of bail in the present case.
5. A copy of this order be sent to the accused/applicant by e-mail through the Superintendent of the Jail concerned.
6. The requisite bail bonds and surety bonds not furnished. Papers be attached with the remand papers.
