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First Bail application Under Section 438 Cr.PC.

ORDER:

1. By this order, this Court intends to deal with the present

bail application under Section 438 Cr.PC having been filed by applicant Jasveer Kaur @ Jaswinder Kaur.

2. Notice of the bail application was served upon the State through learned Additional PP alongwith copy of bail application, who received the same, appeared and contested the bail application on merits. Police record was requisitioned which has been received and perused.

3. I have heard the respective contentions of both the learned Advocates and have perused the record with their able assistance.

4. This FIR under section 498-A. 406 IPC was registered against the applicant and her son and her husband/non applicants Govind Soni and Balbir Soni respectively at the instance of complainant Sonia with the allegations of her harassment and maltreatment at the hands of applicant and her son and her husband non applicants on account of the demands of dowry and misappropriation of her Istridhan. The careful perusal of the FIR reveals that entrustment of gold ring, gold set, Silver Anklet and Ladies watch is stated to have been made to the present applicant and even the bail application has been opposed on the ground that

pendency of recovery of such articles from the possession of present applicant. Keeping in view the fact that the applicant is the mother in law of complainant, before finally deciding the bail application, it is appropriate to direct the applicant to join investigation before the next date of hearing in this bail application. Hence the applicant is directed to join investigation accordingly and in the event her arrest, the I.O./S.H.O. Police Station City-II, Abohar is directed to release the applicant on bail on her furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to his satisfaction and subject to the conditions under Section 438 (2) Cr.PC.

5. Bail application stands adjourned to 11.10.2021 for report of compliance and arguments for final disposal of this bail application.
