ORDER

This Court is convened through video conferencing. This order of mine shall dispose of a bail application under Section 439 Cr.P.C. filed by accused-applicant Jagdev Singh seeking regular bail in the above noted FIR, which was registered on the statement of Omkar Singh, who alleged that he was working as Incharge on a liquor vend and on 22.09.2020 at about 7.30 a.m, he was coming on a liquor vend at Takhandwad to receive cash where accused-applicant Jagdev Singh along with his co-accused Jugla son of Jagdev Singh came and under the influence of liquor, they started abusing him. He alleged that co-accused Jugla was having a bottle of petrol and he poured the same on the liquor vend and the accused-applicant set it

on fire and when the people gathered at the spot on hearing their *raula*, the accused persons ran away from the spot.

2. Ld. Counsel for the accused-applicant argued that the accused-applicant was innocent and all the allegations mentioned in the FIR were totally false. He argued that the accused-applicant was in custody since 23.09.2020 and no recovery was effected from his possession. It was prayed that the accused-applicant may be released on regular bail.

3. Upon notice, the Ld. Addl.P.P appeared on behalf of the State and contested the bail application. Police file was received.

4. I have heard the Ld. Counsel for the applicant and Ld Addl.P.P for the State and I am of the considered opinion that the bail application deserves to be dismissed.

5. Perusal of police file shows that there are serious allegations against the accused-applicant that he along with his co-accused Vikramjit Singh @ Jugla set the liquor vend on fire by pouring petrol. Thus, keeping in view the gravity of offence, no ground is made out to release the accused-applicant on regular bail. There are apprehensions that if released on bail, the accused-applicant may intimidate the witnesses. Consequently, his bail application is dismissed. File be consigned to the record room.
