2. It is stated by the applicant that applicant did not appear before the trial court on 08.11.2019 due to sudden death of her uncle and she could not inform her counsel, due to which his non bailable warrants were issued. The non appearance of bail applicant was neither intentional not willful.

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3. Heard. The perusal of original file reveal that accused got herself absented from the court on 08.11.2019 and her non bailable warrants has been issued. The plea taken by the applicant that due to sudden death of her uncle, she could not inform her counsel. So, from the perusal of file, it stands established that absence of accused on the day of her absent was neither willful nor intentional.

4. Keeping in view the contents of the application and the fact that she has not been declared as proclaimed offender and also the fact that challan in this case has already been presented and accused/applicant is no more required for the purpose of investigation and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the accused applicant in custody, As such, application in hand is, hereby, allowed and accused-applicant is directed to surrender before the court within 7 days from today and on her doing so, she is ordered to be released on bail on her furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs. 70,000/- with two sureties in the like amount. It is made clear that in case, accused-applicant fails to put his appearance within 7 days from today before trial court, in that eventuality, this order of mine shall be deemed to be inoperative.
