Vijay Sah & Ors. Vs. The State of Bihar

14.02.2023 The present anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of petitioners namely (1) Vijay Sah (2) Vikash Kumar Sah (3) Raj Kumar Sah (4) Amarjit Kumar Sah and (5) Satyanarayan Sah is taken up for hearing today.

Today none has turned up to move this bail petition on call.

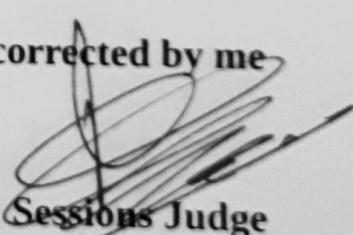
After repeating many times on call no one present to move this bail petition and after perusal of bail petition it transpires that this bail petition is about two months old, which shows that the learned counsel for the petitioners has lost their interest to move this anticipatory bail petition.

Learned PP has submitted that the petitioner has lost their interest to move this bail petition, so, this anticipatory bail petition may be dismissed as none tuned up.

In view of the above facts as well as the submission made by learned Public Prosecutor, in my view, the petitioners has lost their interest to move the present bail petition.

Accordingly, the present bail petition is dismissed as none turned up.
