ORDER

1. Arguments on bail application filed by applicant/accused Sanjeev Kumar @ Sahil under Section 483 of BNSS, for releasing him on regular bail in this case bearing FIR No. 148 dated 08.09.2025 under Sections 115 (2),126(2), 351(3), 140(3), 109,191(2), 191(3), 190 of BNS, Police Station Nangal, heard. Police Record produced and perused.
2. Learned counsel for the applicant/accused has argued that applicant/accused has been falsely implicated in this case. He has not committed the alleged offence. Applicant/accused was arrested on 08.09.2025. Nothing is required to be recovered from the possession of applicant/accused. Therefore, it is prayed, that applicant/accused may kindly be released on bail.
3. On the other hand learned Additional Public Prosecutor has vehemently argued that applicant/accused, in connivance with his co-accused Gagandeep Singh, gave beating to complainant Kush son of Ashok Kumar on 07.09.2025 when complainant was celebrating his

birthday with his friend at Hotel Mussa, village Badalheri, PS Nangal. Therefore, it is prayed, that the bail application moved by applicant/accused may kindly be dismissed.

4. ASI Ram Kumar No.288/R who has brought the record has suffered a statement that except the present FIR, no other FIR has been registered against the applicant/accused Sanjeev Kumar.

5. As per allegations of the prosecution, on 07.09.2025 complainant Kush son of Ashok Kumar was celebrating his birthday along with his friends at Hotel Mussa village Badalheri, PS Nangal and when complainant along with his friend came out from the hotel at about 9:50 PM, two persons namely Nitin Kumar and Gagandeep Singh came there and Gagandeep started abusing him and gave beatings to the complainant and 8/10 more person came there from the said hotel and they have also gave beating to the complainant. In the mean time, one Aman Agni came there and rescued the complainant from the clutches of accused persons but applicant/accused in the mean time gave Glass blow which hit on the head of Aman Agni and Gagandeep gave gave blow with some sharp edged weapon upon said Aman Agni which hit on the head of Aman Agani and blood was started oozing from the head of Gagan Agani. Thereafter complainant, in order to save Aman Agni fled away from the spot along with Aman Agani. Though the injuries attributed to applicant/accused was declared simple in nature and the

name of applicant/accused does not figure in the FIR but he in prosecution of the common object of unlawful assembly formed by him with his co-accused has caused number of simple and grievous hurt on the vital part (head) of complainant Aman Agni by sharp edged weapon and gave swear beatings to complainant. Moreover, two other accused are yet to be arrested in this case. Hence, keeping in view the gravity of the offence, this Court does not find any justification to grant relief of regular bail to applicant/accused. Hence, the regular bail application moved by the applicant/accused is dismissed. File of this bail application be consigned to the record room.
