State Vs Narinder Singh alias Bunty

Heard on bail application moved by applicant/accused Narinder
Kumar alias Bunty. It is averred in the application that accused/applicant never
committed any offence alleged in above said FIR rather the whole version
narrated in the FIR is concocted one. Alleged recovery whatsoever has been
recovered from the accused/applicant and nothing is due to recover from the
accused/applicant. No purpose can be served by putting the applicant behind
the bar by the State. Respectables of the area are ready to stand as for the
surety of the accused/applicant and accused/applicant has the permanent place
of abode at Gidderbaha and there is no chance of his abscond. Prayer is made
to allow the application.

Notice of the application is given to Learned APP for the State
who opposed the same by filing written reply that police has recovered 5 grams
Heroin (White Powder) from the accused/applicant. One other FIR no.62 dated
06.04.2022, under section 21, 22, 27, 29, 61,85 of NDPS Act was registered
against accused/applicant. Accused/applicant is required to be kept in judicial
lockup in order to save the evidence. Prayer is made to dismiss the application.

Perusal of the file shows that FIR in this case was registered for
the offences under sections 21 (A), 61, 85 of NDPS Act. Learned APP for the

State in the reply has mentioned that one another FIR has been registered against the accused, which shows that accused is habitual person for committing offences. If the accused is released on bail, I am of the considered view that he may temper with the evidence. Allegations leveled against accused are serious in nature. This Court is not inclined to take any lenient view against accused. So, in view of above said facts and circumstances, application filed by accused/applicant is dismissed. Papers be tagged with remand papers. Papers be tagged with remand papers fixed for 09.11.2022.
