ORDER

1. This is further to the interim protection order passed on 18/07/2025 in the petition filed by the aggrieved persons / petitioners against respondent u/s 23(2) of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act in MC 73/2025.

2. Petitioner represented. Respondent represented. Heard both the sides. There is already an interim protection order in favour of the petitioner allowed as on 18/07/2025. Respondent would concede that he do not intend to forcibly take the minor child from the custody of the petitioner, otherwise than by due process of law. He is also ready to provide reasonable maintenance to the petitioners during the pendency of the case. Accordingly, interim maintenance is allowed at the rate of Rs.10,000/- to the 1st petitioner and Rs.5,000/- to the minor child / 2nd petitioner until further orders. In addition, it is submitted that the respondent is ready to provide the future medical expenses of the child, if any which is also recorded.
