

Deepak Verma Vs. State

Record has not been produced. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the accused-applicant has been falsely implicated in this case and that the FIR has been got registered on false facts. He further submits that nothing is to be recovered from accused-applicant and complainant company official alleges to have purchased some duplicate articles from the shop of the applicant but there is no report of any laboratory or agency as regards the same nor any purchase bill is stated to have been handed over by him. He submits that custodial interrogation of the applicant-accused is not required and that he is ready to join the investigation and cooperate in the same.

Investigating officer along with record be called for 17.9.2021. Heard. In the meantime, it is directed that in the event of arrest of the applicants/accused, they be released on interim bail by the Investigating officer/Arresting officer to its satisfaction and subject to the applicants complying with the conditions as enshrined under Section 438 (2) of Cr.PC. They shall join the investigation as and when asked by the Investigating Officer; they shall not tamper with the prosecution evidence and they shall not leave the country without prior permission of the court.
