1. It is submitted that matter has been settled between the parties in Mediation Centre.

2. It is submitted by Id counsel for applicant that the matter has been settled now purpose shall be served by keeping the accused person in JC. It is submitted that accused person are respectable person and they have no previous involvement.

3. It is submitted by Id counsel for respondent in view of settlement, they have no objection if the bail is granted to accused subject to fulfilling the conditions of settlement deed.

4. It is submitted by Ld Addl PP that bail cannot be granted on the basis of settlement between parties and no ground is made out for grant of bail.

Considering the custody period of applicant and also taking note of the fact that there is no previous involvement of applicant, and also taking note of no objection of complainant, the application is allowed. Applicant/accused Nilesh is admitted to bail on furnishing personal bond in sum of Rs. 20,000/- with one surety of like amount subject to the conditions that:

(a) Applicant/accused shall not commit the same offence again & must not threaten the witnesses;

(c) Applicant/accused shall provide his fresh address by way of an affidavit in the Court after his release and in case of any change in his address shall inform the Court;

(c) Applicant/accused shall appear on each and every date of hearing before the Court.

7. Application stands disposed off. Copy dasti. Copy of this order be also sent to Jail Superintendent.
