Petition u/s.482 BNSS is filed to grant anticipatory bail to petitioner.

This Petition has come up for final hearing before this court today, in the presence of Thiru.V. Chinnadurai, Advocate for petitioners and the learned Public Prosecutor for prosecution.

Heard both side.

ORDER

The petitioner is alleged to have committed offences on 13.06.2026 u/s.296(b), 324(4), 351(3) of BNS and Section 4 of TNPHW Act.

The case of the prosecution is that, the petitioner along with the co-accused have abused the de-facto complainant who is a lady with filthy language, damaged her house door and also threatened with dire consequences and thereby harassed the de-facto complainant.



The learned Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is an innocent and not at all committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution and no previous case against this petitioner and due to family dispute false case has been registered and that the petitioner is ready and willing to furnish sufficient sureties for his release on anticipatory bail and that therefore, the petitioner may be enlarged on anticipatory bail.

The learned Public Prosecutor has raised strong objection to release the petitioner on anticipatory bail by stating that, totally two accused in this case and this petitioner is the 1st accused and that this petitioner is the son in law of the de-facto complainant and he married the complainant's daughter and their marriage is a love marriage and on 13.06.2026, when the complainant was in his house, accused persons came there, quarreled with her, spoke abusive words and damaged the window glass to the value of Rs.3,000/- and further stated that no previous case against this petitioner.

Considering the above facts and circumstances of the case and the fact that, no previous case against this petitioner and the learned Public prosecutor has not raised any serious objection, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner subject to the following conditions:

i) In the event of arrest or on surrender, the petitioner is ordered to be released on anticipatory bail on executing a bond for Rs.10,000/- with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate No.III, Thoothukudi,

ii) The petitioner shall deposit cash security of Rs.1,500/- (Rupees One thousand and five hundred only) before the Judicial Magistrate Court No.III, Thoothukudi and the de-facto complainant is permitted to withdraw the amount on filing necessary memo before the concerned court.



iii) The petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated u/s.482 (2) (i), (ii) and (iii) of BNSS,

iv) The petitioner shall appear and sign before the respondent police station daily at 10.00 A.M from the date of release for a period of 30 days,

v) The petitioner shall surrender before Judicial Magistrate within 15 days from the date of this order, failing which, the anticipatory bail granted to the petitioner shall stand dismissed automatically,

vi) If the petitioner breaches any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Judicial Magistrate is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed by the said officer as laid down by **the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji .vs. State of Kerala (2005 AIR SCW 5560)**,

vii) And if the petitioner, thereafter abscond, a fresh F.I.R may be registered against the petitioner u/s.269 of BNS.
