**ORDER**

- 1) Vide this order, I shall dispose of the anticipatory bail application filed by the accused/ applicant in the above mentioned case.
- 2) Record received. Heard. It is mentioned in the bail application that accused/ applicant has been falsely implicated in this case, otherwise, he has nothing to do with the alleged offence. It is further averred that accused/ applicant has been arrested by the police on 31.01.2025 and was produced before Illaqa Magistrate and since then, he is in judicial lock-up. It is further averred that nothing is to be recovered from the accused/ applicant and is no more required for any purpose. It is further averred that challan has already been presented in the Court and all the witnesses are interested in the success of the case. It is further averred that conclusion of trial is likely to take a considerable time, so no useful

purpose shall be served by keeping the accused behind bars for an indefinite period. Hence the bail application.

3) Ld.counsel for the accused/ applicant while arguing in the lines of his bail application, contended that bail application may be allowed.

4) Conversely, learned Addl.PP for the State submitted that there are serious allegations against the accused/ applicant and bail application may be dismissed.

5) After hearing rival submissions, it has transpired that instant case was registered on the allegations that on 24.1.2025, accused persons in connivance with each other attacked Kala Singh by forcibly entering his house and committed murder of Jatinder Singh. On the statement of Kala Singh, accused persons were arrested and after completion of investigation, challan was presented.

6) Record reveals that allegations against the accused are serious and grave in nature and keeping in view the seriousness of the matter, accused/ applicant does not deserve concession of regular bail. Resultantly, instant bail application is dismissed. File be attached with the main file.
