The application for anticipatory bail U/s.482 BNSS filed by the petitioners as named above is taken up for hearing.

Heard the Ld. lawyer for the accused petitioners and the Ld. P.P. Murshidabad.

It is also submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the petitioners that no such application for bail on the selfsame cause of action has ever been filed before or rejected by the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta, to which, the Ld. P.P. expressed his agreement.

Ld. P.P. Murshidabad has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail by citing the injury report available in the C.D.

Perused the FIR and the materials gathered in the C.D.

Considered the allegation vis-à-vis the injury report as cited by Ld. P.P. Murshidabad and as available in the C.D. issued by Medical Officer, Jangipur SD Hospital vide report dated 06.05.2026.

Considered the nature of injury and other materials gathered in the C.D.

After considering the same, it appears to me that custodial detention of the present accused petitioners will not serve any substantial purpose for the investigation.

Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail stands **allowed**.

Accordingly, in the event of arrest of the petitioners as named above in c/w the above noted P.S. case, they shall be released on furnishing bail bond of **Rs.3,000/- each** with two sureties of **Rs.1,500/- each**, subject to the satisfaction of the arresting officer.

If released on bail, the petitioners are directed to comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 482(2) of BNSS.

The Crl. Misc. Case is thus disposed of.
