To-day is the date fixed for appearance of the parties.

Claimant files hazira along with postal receipt and track report.

Ld. Advocate for the claimant is present.

From the postal track report it is revealed that notice served to OP nos.1 and 2 except OP no.1 namely Subhojit Naiya, issued by this court that is considered as good service, hence service of summon issued upon OP no. 1 and 2 deem complete except OP no.1 namely Subhojit Naiya.

Opposite parties take no steps and found absent on repeated calls.

Hence, the case be proceed exparte upon opposite parties except OP no.1 Subhojit Naiya.

Ld. Advocate for the claimant files a petition u/s 159 of the M.V.Act praying for directing I/C, Lake Police Station to furnish detail accident report along with relevant copies of the documents relating to Lake Police Station case no. 45 of 2026 dated 07.03.2026 u/s 281/125(b) of BNS as same is necessary for proper adjudication of this case.

I have heard the submission of Ld. Advocate for the claimant and perused the record.

From the record it is revealed that I/C, Lake Police Station has not complied section 159 of the M.V.Act. In this circumstances I/C, Lake Police Station is directed to filed detail accident report along with attested true copy of FIR, Charge Sheet, Seizure List and xerox copies of documents of the offending vehicle including insurance policy and driving license immediately, within the next date fixed.

With above observation the petition dated 15.05.2026 filed on behalf of the claimant u/s 159 of M.V.Act is allowed.

Let the copy of this order be sent to I/C, Lake P.S. for compliance.

Fix. 09.06.2026 for report from Lake P.S. positively and receiving service report upon OP no.1 namely Subhojit Naiya.
