

EMPLOYEE PROVIDENT FUND v. M/s M T METAL

1) Advocate Sh. Rakesh Kumar Sharma has got his statement recorded to the effect that the department has filed no appeal against the order dated 19.12.2019 passed by the then JMIC, Amritsar. He also placed on record the document Ex.CA issued by the department to this effect.

2) The present application for releasing the cash surety of Rs.40,000/- has been filed by the applicant Anirudh Mehra submitting that he had deposited cash surety vide receipt No.96622 dated 25.04.2019 as per the order of the predecessor. That, as no appeal has been filed by the department, the cash surety be released.

3) Heard. As per record, the applicant (accused No.5) was acquitted vide order dated 19.12.2019 passed by the then learned JMIC, Amritsar in COMA/26013/2013 titled as EPFO v. M/s. M.T. Metals and others. The report of the Reader has been obtained who has reported that the applicant had deposited the cash surety of Rs.40,000/- on 25.04.2019. As no appeal has been preferred by the department till date, the surety stands discharged. The present application thus stands allowed and the cash surety of the amount of Rs.40,000/- be released in favour of the applicant Anirudh Mehra. The application stands disposed off and be consigned to the record room.
