Heard. Present FIR has been lodged by Harchand Singh engaged by group of liquor contractors to carry raid on persons involved in illicit trade of liquor and to collect the cash from the liquor vends. Present occurrence is stated to have taken place as complainant used to stop accused persons from indulging in trade of illicit liquor. Learned counsel for applicant-accused has stated that complainant is muscle man engaged by liquor contractors. He has argued that applicant has no criminal background and that considering motive for occurrence there was no reason for applicant-accused to commit offence under Section 379-B IPC and that under the influence of liquor contractors offence under Section 379-B IPC has been added. He has further argued that except for offence under Sections 452, 379-B IPC all the offences are bailable. Injury suffered by complainant falls under Section 323 IPC. He has argued that applicant-accused a poor labourer has been falsely involved in the present case and applicant-accused has no prior criminal record. Said contentions have been denied by learned Additional Public Prosecutor. Veracity of respective allegations will be determined during trial. In order to facilitate investigation, applicant-accused is directed to join investigation by presenting himself before Investigating officer on 1.10.2020 at 11.00 a.m. and in the event of his arrest, he be released on interim bail on furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of Investigating Arresting Officer.

Bail application is adjourned to 5.10.2020.
