O R D E R

1. Heard on the bail application filed by above named
applicant/accused Raj Singh, under section 483 of BNSS in case
bearing FIR No. 110 Dated 14.06.2024, under section 452, 324, 323,
427, 506, 148, 149 IPC, Police Station Guruharsahai.

2. Learned counsel for the applicant/accused has argued and contended that false case has been registered against the applicant/accused. There is unexplained delay of 21 hours in lodging the FIR. False FIR has been got registered by the complainant after joining hands with police and after fabricating injuries on their persons. Infact civil dispute regarding land is pending between the parties and under that grudge, earlier complainant party got registered FIR No. 285 dated 31.12.2023 against the applicant/accused at Police Station Guruharsahai. Applicant/accused has never entered into the house of the complainant nor inflicted any injury to him. Rather complainant party after entering into the house of complainant inflicted injuries to Sunita Rani daughter of the applicant/accused, for which cross case in FIR No. 285 was registered against the complainant party vide rapat No. 34 dated 31.12.2023. Applicant/accused is in custody since 02.07.2024 and is no more required for further investigation. Hence, a prayer has been made for grant of bail.

3. Notice of the bail application was given to the State, through learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State, who appeared and opposed the present bail applications with the assistance of learned counsels for the complainant on the ground that applicant/accused has been duly named in the FIR and he has actively

participated in occurrence, wherein he alongwith co-accused caused injuries to complainant Harjinder Singh, his mother Kaushalya Devi and his cousin Arshdeep Singh and also damaged the house hold of the complainant. As such, applicant/accused is not entitled for bail. With these submissions he prayed for dismissal of bail application.

4. Heard. Perusal of the file shows that present FIR has been registered against the applicant/accused and other co-accused/non-applicants on the statement of complainant Harjinder Singh with the allegations that the applicant/accused alongwith other co-accused formed an unlawful assembly and they while being armed with deadly weapons forcibly entered into his house and caused injuries to him, his mother and cousin. There are specific allegations against the applicant/accused that he was armed with gandasa and he caused injury on the head of the complainant and arm of Arshdeep Singh. Moreover, learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State has also submitted that besides this present FIR, two more FIRs are registered against the applicant/accused i.e. FIR No.112 dated 15.06.2024 and FIR No. 285 dated 31.12.2023, which are registered at Police Station Guruharsahai and in both these FIRs, similar allegations are there against the applicant/accused. So, at this stage it appears that the applicant/accused is a habitual offender and there is apprehension that if released on bail,

he can tamper with the evidence or can make inducement or threat to the complainant or witnesses. So, considering the above said facts, no ground is made out to grant concession of bail to the applicant/accused. Accordingly application in hand is hereby dismissed. Any thing staged in this order shall have no bearing on the merits of the case. File be consigned to the record room.
