Today is fixed for production, hearing of the bail petitions and I/O's report.

Ld. P.P in-charge is present with the C.D.

Ld. Advocates on behalf of the accused persons, namely, Koushik Das @ Bubun and Sk. Yusuf are also present.

Now the bail petitions dt. 22.12.2022 are taken up for hearing.

Ld. Advocate for the accused person, namely, Sk. Yusuf submitted that the accused/petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and he has been languishing in judicial custody since in 10.10.2022. It is further submitted that the seizure list dt.12.10.2022 was concocted and fabricated by the I/O. It is further submitted that the accused person will not abscond if he is enlarged on bail and prays for enlargement on bail under any terms and conditions. It is further submitted no such application for bail is either pending before or rejected by any superior court in respect of the accused /petitioner.

Ld. Advocate for the accused person, namely, Koushik Das @ Bubun submitted that the accused/petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and he has been languishing in judicial custody since in 08.10.2022. It is further submitted that the accused person will not abscond if he is enlarged on bail and prays for enlargement on bail under any terms and conditions. It is further submitted that no such application for bail is either pending before or rejected by any superior court in respect of the accused /petitioner.

Ld. P. P. on the other hand raises strong objection categorically stating that the investigation is in the initial stage and there are sufficient materials against the accused persons.

Perused the case record and case diary and other materials available thereon and on perusal of the same I find that the accused person, Sk. Yusuf was brought under arrest on 10.10.2022 and accused Koushik Das @ Bubun was brought under arrest on 08.10.2022. I also find that the investigation is going on and the alleged offences are grievous in nature and if the accused persons are enlarged on bail there is every possibility of hampering the investigation and tampering the evidence and as such I am not inclined to allow the bail prayer. Hence the bail prayer stands **rejected**.

Bail petitions are thus disposed off.
