Today is fixed for taking steps by the petitioner.

Ld. Counsel appearing for the petitioner moves an application under Order V Rule 17 read with Order V Rule 19 of C.P.C. and prays for substituted service of summons on the O.Ps and treat the service of summons upon the O.Ps as duly effected.
