Petitioner takes steps through his Ld. Lawyer. OP also takes steps through his Ld. Lawyer. Today is fixed for further examination-in-chief of PW1 but on behalf of the petitioner, one time petition is filed on the ground that some documents which are likely to be produced as evidence have been lost and petitioner lodged complaint to the concerned police station. So, some times are required to obtain those original documents.

In support of their submission, they have filed copy of Burtalla P.S. G.D. Entry no. 528 dated 08.11.2018 and relevant page of copy of Aajkal Papers publication dated 22.11.2018. Ld. Lawyer for the OP orally submits that if the documents as furnished in relevant G.D. are produced by the petitioner for marking those exhibited in their behalf then they would give a consent so that case to be proceeded on merit. Ld. Lawyer for the petitioner has undertaken that on next date xerox copy of those to be produced and evidence to be proceeded by marking those documents exhibited.

Accordingly, the case is adjourned today fixing 07.12.2019.

To 07.12.2019 for further examination-in-chief of PW1. The prayer of extension of ad interim order made by the petitioner is allowed and extended till that date. Let the copy of relevant G.D. Entry and Aajkal paper be kept with the record for future reference.
