Today is fixed for issuance of writ of delivery of possession.

Dhr files an application supported by an affidavit stating that there is no order of stay of the execution of the decree dated 18.09.2014 passed in T.S. 416 of 2002 by any Court of law.

Dhr also files the Writ of execution and Process fee.

Dhr filed a petition on 16.12.2024 praying for breaking open the padlock.

Heard. Perused the petition. The Dhr has prayed for an order to break open the pad lock at the time of execution if required.

Considered.

For the sake of execution of the decree I am inclined to allow the prayer of the Dhr and direct the Seal Bailiff that he is at liberty to break open the pad lock for the purpose of execution of the decree.

On careful scrutiny of the case record and affidavit filed today, it appears that there is no stay order in this case from any higher forum.

Hence, the writ for delivery of possession of the decretal property in terms of the decree be issued upon observance of all official formalities through the Seal Bailiff of the court.

Bailiff is directed to execute the writ with the help of police personnel of P.S- Posta and to break open the padlock, if any at the time of execution.

O.C. of P.S- Posta is also directed to assist the Seal Bailiff to execute the decree.

The Dhr has put in requisites for issuance of writ.
