Plaintiffs file hazira through his Ld. Advocate along with original postal receipt about the service of summons. Defendant on receiving summons entered his appearance by filing fresh vakalatnama along with an application that copy of the plaint without enclosing any copy of the documents upon which plaintiff has sought for reliance has been served.

At this juncture, Ld. Lawyer for the defendant submits that plaintiff should be directed to supply all the copy of the documents along with copy of the list of documents as per Order 7 Rule 14 of the CPC. Ld. Lawyer for the defendant further submits that the copy of the plaint is illegible and some portions remained blank.

On perusal of the plaint in the record, it appears that a number of paras, some portion has been incorporated including date in handwriting and in a plaint, neither there is any list of the documents nor the copy of the documents.

It is totally non-compliance of Order 7 Rule 14 CPC.

In this juncture, plaintiff is directed to file list of the documents and all the copies of the documents upon which he wants to rely after supplying the copies to the defendant including illegible copies of the documents on the date fixed below.

To 22.01.2020 for compliance the Order 7 Rule 14 CPC. Otherwise, plaintiff not to be allowed to proceed the case further by adducing any evidence.
