Today is fixed for extension of the ad-interim order of injunction.

Plaintiff files hazira along with a petition praying for extension of the ad interim order of injunction, on the ground stated therein, and a petition praying for condonation of delay due to late filing of the extension petition. Copies served.

Defendant No. 2 to 4 and 6 file hazira and raise strong objection to both the said petitions on the ground that the said petition has been filed late today.

Perused. Heard both sides.

It appears that the extension petition has indeed been filed late today.

However, in my opinion, for such a technical reason like late filing , it would not be proper for the interest of justice, to reject the said extension petition, and vacate the ad-interim order of injunction.

As such, the said petition praying for condonation of delay due to late filing of the said extension petition is considered and allowed.

Consequently, the extension petition is considered and allowed, for the ends of proper justice, but subject to payment of costs of Rs. 2000/- to the defendant No. 2 to 4 and 6.

Ad-interim order of injunction is extended till 18.12.2024 .
