Order No.04/dated 23.08.2023:

Applicant files hazira along with copies of some documents through her Ld. Lawyer.

The case is taken up for hearing of application dated 19.06.2023 praying for injunction restraining the legal heirs of the deceased from withdrawing, transferring, utilizing, enjoying and/or creating any third party interest and/or encumbering the 1/4th undivided share of the applicant, Rajasree Banerjee upon the assets left by the deceased Partha Protim Nath.

Heard the Ld. Lawyer for the applicant/petitioner.

Considering the submissions of the Ld. Counsel for the applicant and also considering the urgency in the matter this court is of the view that ad-interim injunction may be granted in the matter for a period of 10 days.

Ad-interim injunction is allowed for 10 days restraining the legal heirs of the deceased, namely, Niharika nath, Sagarika Nath and Krishna Nath from withdrawing, transferring, utilizing, enjoying and/or creating any third party interest and/or encumbering the 1/4th undivided share of the applicant upon the assets left by the deceased Partha Protim Nath.

Issue notice to all the legal heirs of the deceased.
