Order No. 08 dated 28.11.2023:

It is submitted by the Ld. Counsel appearing for the O.P. that two applications were made by her client praying for vacating the interim order passed by this Court and the other for serving copies upon the Ld. Counsel for the O.P.

It is also submitted that after such application praying for copies was made, Ld. Counsel for the O.P. has received copies from the Ld. counsel appearing for the petitioner. She therefore is not pressing for the said application.

Regarding the application for vacating the interim order of said application is also not pressed by the Ld. Counsel and she prays for time to file written objection on the main application for Letters of Administration.

Such prayer of the Ld. Counsel for the O.P. is allowed and the Ld. Counsel is given three weeks time to file her written objection.

It is further submitted by the Ld. Counsel for the O.P. that they have reliably learnt that the petitioner has withdrawn certain amount from the bank accounts, but she has no specific knowledge about it. It is made clear until and unless the instant application filed by the petitioner praying for Letters of Administration is heard and disposed of by this Court, there shall be an order directing all the parties not to withdraw any amount from any account held by the deceased Partha Protim Nath.

A copy of this order may be supplied to both the parties countersigned by the Bench Clerk so that the banks or any other authorities may be informed of the fact that no amount to be disbursed to any party till such time the Court disposes of the application for Letters of Administration filed by the petitioner Rajasree Banerjee.

Fix 19.12.2023 for filing written objection by the O.P. and further orders.
