ORDER BELOW EXH. 01

1. Applicant has filed present application for return of property i.e Tata Intra Motor bearing No. MH 01 DR8041, Colour White and Josh Blue worth Rs. 3,00,000/-
2. Read the application and say. I. O and Ld APP have raised strong objection while granting interim custody of the muddemal to the applicant/informant.
3. Perused the photocopies of documents on record. It seems that present applicant is registered owner of vehicle. Moreover, he has filed his Affidavit, copies of FIR, registration certificate of vehicle, Aadhar and Pan card
4. Considering the facts and documents on record, it seems, the applicant is registered owner of the muddemal. Thus, he has better right to take the interim custody of the muddemal. On the other hand, if the application is rejected, possibility of damage to the muddemal property can not be ruled out. Hence, the application will have to be granted. Therefore, following order;

ORDER

- 1) The application is allowed.
- 2) Interim custody of Tata Intra Motor bearing No. MH 01 DR8041, Colour White and Josh Blue worth Rs. 3,00,000/- be given to the applicant till the conclusion of the trial of Cri. No.322/2026 on executing indemnity bond of Rs. 3,00,000/- (Rs. Three Lakhs only)

before the Investigating Officer. The Investigating Officer is directed to take photograph of said vehicle and the receipt of handing over the possession of the muddemal from the applicant.

3) The applicant shall not transfer the above mentioned muddemal by any mode or alter the same till the conclusion of trial of the above mentioned crime.

4) The applicant shall produce the above mentioned muddemal before the court as and when required.
