This petition came before me on this day for hearing in the presence of Thiru. U. Sivasubramanian, Advocate for the petitioner and the learned Special Public Prosecutor for the State and upon hearing the arguments and on perusal of the case records this court delivers the following:-

ORDER

1. This petition is filed u/s.483 BNSS to relax the condition imposed in Cr.M.P.No.268/2026, dated 18.05.2026.

2. The petitioner was granted bail with condition for the offences u/s. u/s.296(b), 115(2), 118(1), 351(2) BNS and Sec.3(1)(r), 3(1)(s), 3(2)(va) of SC/ST Act vide order of this court in Cr.M.P.No. 268/2026, dated 18.05.2026 that the petitioner shall report and sign before the respondent police station daily at 10.00 a.m., until further order. The petitioner is regularly observing the condition from 21.05.2026 to till date.

The petitioner is the only breadwinner of his family. If the condition is relaxed, the petitioner will not abscond or evade due process of law.

4. The learned Public Prosecutor has submitted that the petitioner has complied the condition from 21.05.2026 to 08.06.2026.

5. The learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner is regularly complied the condition for the past 19 days. The Special Public Prosecutor stated that the petitioner is regularly complied the condition from 21.05.2026 to 08.06.2026. Considering the nature of offences alleged against the petitioner and considering the submissions made on both sides, this court is inclined only to modify the condition imposed on the petitioner in Cr.M.P.No.268/2026, dated 18.05.2026. Accordingly, this petition is partly allowed and the condition is modified that the petitioner is directed to appear before the respondent P.S monthly twice (i.e) on 1st and 15th day of every month at 10.00 a.m., till the filing of charge sheet and the other conditions shall remain unaltered.
