Order No. 6 dated 28.03.2025:

Appellant files an application under Section 151 of CPC prying for amendment on the grounds as stated therein.

Heard the Ld. Lawyer for the appellant.

It is submitted by the Ld. Lawyer for the appellant that at the time of filing the instant appeal, due to typographical error the address of defendant no.3 has been written as "26/1A, Tarak Chatterjee Lane, Kolkata-700 007" instead of "26/2A, Tarak Chatterjee Lane, Kolkata-700 005", which is required to be corrected. Accordingly, he prayed that to correct or amend the aforesaid averments as per "Schedule" to the amendment application filed today.
