It appears that till date no service has been made upon the Respondents as per direction passed by this Court vide order dated 20.05.2025 and 21.05.2025.

The appellant annexed a photocopy of order dated 07.05.2025 passed by Ld. Sole Arbitrator wherefrom it appears that Ld. Sole Arbitrator in his order dated 07.05.2025, ordered as follows:

“ So long as the vehicle in question remains in custody of the custodian, he shall remain responsible for the safely and security of the said vehicle. The said vehicle shall be in the custody of the custodian until further order of this Tribunal”.

It appears Ld. Tribunal appointed Mr Rana Yadav, Advocate as a receiver custodian in respect of the vehicle in question.

In view of the above order passed by the Ld. Sole Arbitrator, this Court finds no urgency to hear the injunction application ex-parte.

Let the matter be heard on 27.06.2025 for hearing of the appeal on the point of admission and hearing of the application under section 151 of the C.P.C dated 20.05.2025 filed by the appellant.

Appellant is directed to serve the copy of injunction application and copy of appeal to the Respondents in the meantime.
