Examination in chief by I/C Public Prosecutor

1. I am serving as Asst. Professor , Department of Forensic Medicine, Victoria Hospital, Bengaluru since October 2009.

2. On 14.11.2020 the I.O of the present case sent a requisition along with dead body of one Smt. Kempamma to hold Post Mortem examination on her dead body. Accordingly I conducted Post Mortem examination on the dead body from 1.30 p.m. to 2.15 p.m. and submitted my report. While conducting Post Mortem examination I found following external injuries.

a. Degloving injury measuring 27cm x 19cm x muscle / tendon deep present over right forearm exposing underlying irregularly cut muscle and tendon fibre and vessels of right forearm.

3. The cause of death was due to injuries sustained. The above injuries are antemortem in nature. In this regard I have issued post mortem report, which is now marked as Ex.P.10, it bears my signature marked as Ex.P.10(a).

Cross Examination by Sri D.M.M Advocate.

4. It is true to suggest that the exact depth of injuries is not mentioned in the P.M. report. It may be true that if a vehicle drags on a person on the rough surface, the said person may receive some scratch injuries on his body. It is false to suggest that the injuries mentioned in the post

mortem report do not cause the death, and I have issued a false P.M. report at the request of police.
