Order No. 11 dated 03.02.2026 :

Ld. Advocate of both sides are present.

Today is fixed for further cross examination of PW-1.

At this stage, Ld. Advocate on behalf of the opposite party who is contesting the application for granting of letter of administration submits that an application u/o 26 rule 9 C.P.C. dated 24.07.2025 has not yet been disposed of by the Court and therefore he is not in a position to cross examine the witness (PW-1) without the inventory of the bank locker having been done.

On the other hand, Ld. Advocate for the petitioner submits that an inventory was made and it was done in presence of the parties challenging the grant of letters of administration in a previous suit filed by the present petitioner and the report of the said inventory may be used for the purpose of deciding the instant proceeding. The certified copy of the Commissioner's report including the Goldsmith's report have been exhibited in the instant proceeding.

Having considered the submission of both sides, this Court is of the view that hearing of the pending application for inventory commission may be taken up at first.

The instant proceeding is taken off from the P. Board.

Fix 05.03.2026 for hearing of the application u/o 26 r. 9 of C.P.C. dated 24.07.2025.

The liberty is given to the petitioner to file W.O., if not filed earlier.
