Order No. 19 dated 19.11.2025 :

Today is fixed for hearing of petition filed under Order 39 Rule 7 of C.P.C by the petitioner.

Today petitioner filed a petition under Order 39 Rule 7 read with Section 151 of C.P.C. and prayed for appointing an Advocate/Inventory Commissioner to conduct an inventory/inspection/commission work to take measurement of the ornaments lying in the Locker no. 51 with Canara Bank (formerly as Syndicate Bank), Manicktala Branch and to assess the valuation of the ornaments lying in the said locker left by deceased Bijoy Narayan Shaw.

Heard. Perused the petition.

Now, the case is taken up for passing order in respect of the petition for appointing an Advocate/Inventory Commissioner.

It is submitted by the petitioner that she has filed the instant case for getting Letter of Administration in respect of the estate left by the deceased Bijoy Narayan Shaw. It is also contended that the petitioner filed the instant application for appointment of an Advocate Commissioner for conducting commission work and to cause an inspection of the contents lying in the Locker No. 51 lying with Canara Bank (formerly as Syndicate Bank) at premises No. 171D & 173A, Vivekananda Road, P.S- Burtolla, Kolkata – 700006, currently at 58, Raja Dinendra Street, Kolkata- 700006, BSNL Building, P.S- Narkeldanga which is standing in the name of the deceased Bijoy Narayan Shaw in presence of Branch Manager along with a licensed Goldsmith(valuer) and with prior notice to bank and the petitioner. As such, inventory of the said locker is required to establish the assets in the locker by appointing an inventory/Advocate commissioner.

Heard. Considered.

Having heard Ld. Lawyer for the petitioner, this Court is of the view that for proper adjudication of the case, the prayer made by the petitioner in the instant application should be allowed.

Thus, the application praying for appointment of an Advocate Commissioner is allowed.

Priyabrata Ghosh(Contact No. **8622988267**), Ld. Advocate is hereby appointed as an Advocate/Inventory Commissioner for conducting inventory of Locker No. 51 lying with Canara Bank (formerly as Syndicate Bank), Manicktala Branch, currently at 58, Raja Dinendra Street, Kolkata- 700006, BSNL Building, P.S- Narkeldanga standing in the name of the deceased Bijoy Narayan Shaw by visiting the bank.

Ld. Advocate Commissioner shall make inventory of the assets lying in the locker in presence of the petitioner, the Branch Manger or any other Bank Official on behalf of the Branch Manager and a licensed Goldsmith.

The Ld. Advocate Commissioner shall make field note of the same and submit a report along with field note stating details of the inventory before this Court.

Contd. ... Order no. 19 dated 19.11.2025 :

Ld. Advocate Commissioner shall conduct the inventory after serving notice upon the bank authority and the petitioner about 10 days prior to the date of inventory of the locker.

The remuneration of the Ld. Inventory Commissioner will be Rs.7,000/-(Seven Thousand)only, to be paid by the petitioner.

Issue writ accordingly.

Thus, the application is disposed of.

Let a copy of this order be handed over to the Ld. Advocate Commissioner for information and necessary action.
