Order No.20, dated 24.06.2024:

Today is the date fixed for hearing of stay petition along with the petition filed by the appellant on 18.01.2024 and the petition under Section 151 of CPC, written objection, if any, in the meantime.

Ld. Lawyer of the appellant files a petition supported by an affidavit, praying for extension of ad interim order of stay on the grounds as stated therein. Ld. Lawyer also files an application for amendment praying for amendment as per 'schedule of amendment' to the instant petition. Ld.
