Ld. Lawyer for the applicants/petitioners is present before the court. Petitioners also file an application praying for correction of name of the consentee in the affidavit portion wrongly written as Arun Kumar Pugalia instead of Anil Pugalia on the grounds as stated therein. Let it be kept with the record.

Today was the date fixed for evidence.

The petition for correction/amendment is taken up for hearing.

Heard the Ld. Counsel for the petitioner, considered and allowed the petition as the correction/amendment sought for by the petitioner is formal in nature and it will not change the nature and character of the suit.

Let the name of Arun Kumar Pugalia be corrected as Anil Pugalia.

Ld. Counsel for the petitioners is permitted to insert the name of consenting party Anil Pugalia striking out the wrongly written name of Arun Kumar Pugalia.

The case is taken up for taking evidence.

Petitioners Sudha Pugalia and Shailendra Pugalia file two separate affidavit-in-chief through their Ld. Lawyer. Consenting party Anil Pugalia is also present before the court.

They have been examined as P.W.1 and P.W.2 in this case. Documents have been marked as Exbt.1 to Exbt.10 respectively. Consenting party Anil Pugalia also brought on the dock and examined as P.W.3. document from his side has been submitted and marked as Exbt.11.

The evidences of Sudha Pugalia, Shailendra Pugalia and Anil Pugalia are closed and discharged.
