Hazira has been filed on behalf of the defendant. Defendant has filed print out of case status of Title Suit No.2175 of 2025 and print out of order nos.2 and 8 dated 22.09.2025 and 31.03.2026 passed therein, as well as print out of case status of Title Suit No.2134 of 2025 which was filed by the plaintiff herein in the Court of Ld. Judge, Bench-V, City Civil Court, Calcutta and printout of order no. 3 dated 07.01.2026 passed therein.

Ld. Counsel of the defendant has submitted that Title Suit No.2134 of 2025 had been dismissed for default on 07.01.2026 by the Ld. Judge, Bench-V, City Civil Court, Calcutta, whereas the instant Title Suit No.2175 of 2025 had been filed on 22.09.2025 itself and ad-interim order of injunction was obtained on the same day and both the title suits are with respect to the same vehicle.

On perusal of the case record of this case, i.e. Title Suit No.2175 of 2025, it appears that during pendency of Title Suit No.2134 of 2025 in the court of the Ld. 5th Bench, City Civil Court, Calcutta this suit, i.e. Title Suit No.2175 of 2025 had been filed by the plaintiff. Accordingly, the plaintiff is directed to clarify this anomaly by the next date positively failing which this court will be constrained to pass necessary orders in accordance with law. Even though there is a prayer of the plaintiff for extension of the ad-interim order of injunction, however, the Ld. Counsel of the plaintiff has not turned up in the court and moreover considering the fact that the ad-interim order of injunction was possibly obtained by suppressing the fact of T.S. No. 2134 of 2025 filed by the plaintiff herein pending in the court of Ld. 5th Bench, City Civil Court, Calcutta, therefore the ad-interim order of injunction is not being extended today. The defendant is directed to communicate this order to the plaintiff through speed post at once.
