Order No.8, dated 20.01.2026:

Appellant files hazira and payment receipt of Rs.1,50,000/- along with an application praying for extension of the interim order of stay dated 21.11.2025 till the disposal of the instant appeal on the ground stated therein. Appellant also files an adjournment petition fixing another date to hear out the matter on the ground stated therein. Let it be kept with the record.

Ld. Counsel for the respondent files hazira through its Ld. Counsel.

Ld. Counsel for the appellant is present before the Court.

Heard the Ld. Counsels for both sides.

Ld. Counsel for the appellant submitted that out of court there is a talk of settlement going on between the parties and as per settlement his client has made part payment. Accordingly, he prays for time to hear out the matter on another date.

Considering the submission of the Ld. Counsel for the appellant and without going into merit of such settlement process, the prayer for adjournment is considered and allowed.

Interim order be extended till the next date of hearing.

Parties are at liberty to explore the settlement process in accordance with the terms and conditions of the settlement agreement made between themselves.
