Today is fixed for return and order.

The plaintiff has filed a petition prying for extension of ad-interim order of injunction.

The plaintiff has filed 22(11 +11) postal registration slips of injunction and notice as well as summons along 22 India post track reports.

twelve track reports show that defendant nos. 1,2,5,6,8 and 11 have received the items.

Two track reports upon defendant nos. 4 show that item returned with postal remarks “refused” which is tantamount to be good service.

Two track reports upon defendant nos. 3 show that item returned with postal remarks “no such person in the address”.

Two track report upon defendant no. 7 show that item returned with postal remarks “addressee can not be located”.

Four track reports upon defendant nos. 9 and 10 show that item returned with postal remarks “in sufficient address.

Suit and injunction will proceed ex parte against the defendant nos. 2,4,5,6 and 11.

The defendant no. 8 has entered appearance by filing a petition alongwith one Vakalatnama praying for time on the ground stated there in.

Prayer is considered and allowed.

Adjourned to 29.11.2022 for filing written objection and written statement by defendant no. 8.
