

Title Appeal No.88 of 2025

Order No.6, dated 11.05.2026:

Today is fixed for hearing of appeal.

This Court is informed that the respondent being aggrieved with the order dated 04.02.2026 filed an revisional application before the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta. Hence, the hearing of the appeal is adjourned.

The application dated 02.04.2026 filed by the appellant is taken up for hearing in presence of both sides.

Heard Ld. Advocate of both sides.

It is stated by the appellant that the respondent refused to accept the occupational charge paid to him by demand draft drawn in his favour. On the other hand having filed written objection it is stated by the respondent that the demand draft was not purchased by the appellant Manoj Kumar Gupta and it was purchased by one third party. It is further stated that the payment was not made within the time fixed by the Court.

Having considered the submission of both sides, it is found that the payment of occupational charge has not yet been made by the appellant and accepted by the respondent. So, the appellant is further directed to make the payment of occupational charge of the current month as well as the arrears immediately in compliance with the order passed by this Court earlier and in case the respondent is refusing to accept the occupational charge tendered by appellant, he is at liberty to deposit the same in the Court.

The application dated 02.04.2026 is thus disposed of.

Vide order dated 04.02.2026 the stay was granted for a period of twelve weeks. The said period is already expired. Therefore, the appellant prays for extension of the period of stay. Accordingly, the period of stay is extended for further eight weeks or till the disposal of the appeal, whichever is earlier.
