Heard the Ld. Advocates for both sides. Perused the application as well as the record. Considered.

On consideration of the same, I am inclined to allow the application for proper adjudication of the suit.

Hence, it is

Ordered

that the application under Order 22 Rule 2 of the CPC dated 17.03.2026 filed by the plaintiffs is considered and allowed.

Let, the name of the plaintiff No.1 be expunged from the cause title of the plaint.
